The paper should be presented in an explicit manner in accordance with the topic of research and up-to-date scientific methodology. The paper should be based on adequate research strategies and relevant references. The submitted paper should contribute to the development of the research field, and can be written in English, Romanian or Russian.

TITLE (capital letters) in English and in the language in which the article is written (if different).

Ex.: Romanian – **DETERMINĂRI PSIHOPEDAGOGICE ALE ABORDĂRII COMUNICATIVE ÎN PREDAREA LIMBII ENGLEZE**

English – **THE PSYCHOPEDAGOGICAL BASIS OF COMMUNICATIVE APPROACH IN TEACHING ENGLISH**

Abstract in English (200-300 words)
